

Agreement for Multiple Connection Service - Meter

This agreement dated _____, between _____, herein called "Developer", and Double Springs Utility District, herein called "Utility";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Developer has undertaken the establish "multiple units", as defined and allowed by the Utility's "Multiple Connection Policy", for rent or sale of residential units within the Utility's service area and desires that water services be provided to such park.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set out, it is agreed between Utility and Developer as follows:

1. Developer agrees to:
 - A. Take necessary action to have the "multiple units" plat approved by the Planning Commission. Copy of the plat showing such approval is attached.
 - B. Obtain approval for construction from Tennessee Department of Conservation where required.
 - C. Pay all cost of material and installation of proposed lines from the Utility's main line to the master meter and convey an unencumbered title to these lines to the Utility.
 - D. Pay the Utility required tap fee, boring fee and service charges.
 - E. Pay the Utility for water used based on the Utility's "Multiple Connection Policy" a copy this policy is attached to this agreement and applicable rates at the time.
 - F. The Utility will make no guarantees, expressed or implied, as to service quality, quantity, pressure, consistency or continuity. However under normal operating conditions the Utility shall be able to supply water to the meter, in amounts, that the meter is capable of supplying as rated by the AWWA standards.

The Developer agrees to abide by the Utility's "Cross Connection Policy". A copy of the policy is made a part of this agreement.
